6. Discussion with SCYP Staff Megan Banks and Katie Fields

Megan Banks and Katie Field from SCYP were present to discuss the work that will be done over the summer. They would like to hear from the Council on which projects are a priority for them and identify some tangible next steps. Katie Fields reviewed several of the presentations given by the different SCYP classes. There was discussion on Urban Renewal priorities, including the storefront grant or loan program. There was discussion on Economic Development and whether the Council felt it wanted to move forward with the direction the classes went with their research and presentations. Megan will follow up with Ryan Culp, Economic Development Manager, on this topic. There was discussion on a community garden or green house. There was discussion on the Transit/City Center and using ideas from the passive solar heating class. Council and staff reviewed the reports and findings from the Community Engagement and Engaged Journalism classes. There was discussion on social media engagement and working on a “best practices” guide for staff and Council. The group discussed scheduling a joint meeting between the Council and Chamber to discuss the work the Chamber

accomplished with the SCYP class. The class helped the Chamber create a website, publish a news release and helped develop social media accounts for the Chamber to maintain. There was discussion on next steps for the bicycle and pedestrian connectivity class reports and presentations. The Council agreed that this is a big priority and that it ties in to a lot of other ongoing projects. There was discussion on the class that worked with the Senior Center on developing strategies and provided recommendations to change organizational structure and prepare for future needs. The Council would like the Senior Center to present their implementations of some of these ideas at a work session, like the Chamber will be asked to do. There was discussion on the role that the City should play with regard to the Senior Center.

Katie and Megan will take the discussion from tonight and have a report by July 18th. The next meeting will be August 23rd with everything being fully wrapped up by the end of September.

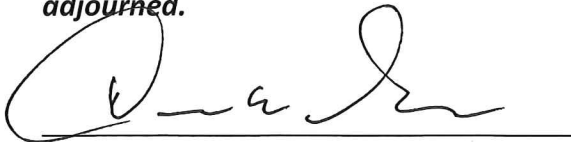

The Council thanked Megan and Katie for coming.

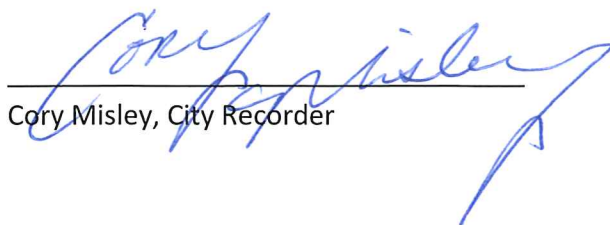
11. Mayor's Comments
