Hi Brent,

I have several concerns with the proposed site plan. Although the application includes "Final Plans," at this stage I would typically expect only a site plan. Accordingly, my comments are limited to site plan considerations at this time. The applicant must coordinate any road improvement reviews with the County and submit the required deposit prior to review of the improvement plans.

Based solely on the site plan, without a detailed review of the improvement plans, I have the following comments:

- Access Location The proposed access point shown on the site plan does not align with the City of Bend (COB) standard drawing included in the application, nor with any County approach standard. The current location—immediately adjacent to the radius of Assembly Way—precludes the installation of the required dustpan approach flare. Incorporating this necessary feature would push the approach limits into the Assembly Way radius, which is unacceptable. Additionally, the proposed access conflicts with the County's spacing requirement per <u>DCC 17.48.090</u>. To address these issues, the approach should be shifted eastward.
- 2. **Drainage** The existing drainage galleries are undersized for the impervious area they serve and require frequent maintenance to remain functional. The proposed frontage improvements would hinder that maintenance and add more impervious area to the right-of-way. As a result, the existing drainage galleries and associated catch basins must be decommissioned and replaced with a more suitable alternative.

The County has a drainage improvement project in this area scheduled to go to bid this spring, with construction expected to be completed by the end of summer. However, the proposed swales from this project will conflict with the sidewalk location shown in the development plans as drafted. Additional coordination is necessary to determine how best to address drainage within this section of the corridor.
