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### **LEGISLATIVE PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

A public hearing has been scheduled before the City of La Pine Planning Commission to receive testimony or comments regarding text amendments to the City of La Pine Zoning Ordinance 2012-05. The proposed text amendments include:

- Section 7. Amend “Application for land use permit, certificate of use, and occupancy”
- Section 8. Add definitions of several marijuana uses
- Section 10. Add marijuana uses to Permitted Uses
- Section 12. Amend Special Uses “Marijuana Dispensaries” to broaden inclusion to “Marijuana Business” and insert additional criteria for marijuana dispensaries, marijuana production facilities, marijuana processing facilities, and marijuana testing laboratories.
- Section 19. Insert parking requirement for marijuana businesses.

Failure to raise an issue in person at the hearing or in writing precludes appeal by that person to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA). Failure to provide statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to LUBA based on that issue.

Interested persons may obtain a Staff Report or the application within seven days of the date of the hearing. Interested persons may review the application at City Hall during normal business hours.
