

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-20

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERING FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF LA PINE CONTINGENCY FUND TO THE CAPITAL FUND WITHIN THE SEWER FUND OF THE CITY'S BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the above-titled matter came to the attention of the City Council (the "Council") of the City of La Pine ("City"), and the Council finds that it is necessary to adjust budget appropriations for the 2016-17 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, this budget adjustment is necessary to reflect various needs that were unanticipated at the time of the budget cycle and preparation, and such budget adjustments are necessary to allow City to perform its duties and be in compliance with Oregon budget law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS 294.471 and 294.473, a public hearing is not required for the proposed budget adjustments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by and through the Council meeting in regular session, the following:


1. The above-stated findings contained in this Resolution No. 2016-20 (this "Resolution") are hereby adopted.
2. The following adjustments are made to City's Sewer Fund for the 2016-17 fiscal year.
