A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA BUSINESS PERMIT APPLICATION, INVESTIGATION, AND LAND USE FEES.

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2016, the City of La Pine ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 2016-10 (the "Ordinance"), pursuant to which City established reasonable time, place, and manner regulations concerning certain recreational marijuana businesses; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the Ordinance provide that the La Pine City Council (the "Council") will establish the amounts of the initial recreational marijuana business permit application and investigation fee and permit renewal application and investigation fee, respectively, from time to time by Council resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by and through the Council meeting in regular session, the following:

- 1. The above-stated findings contained in this Resolution No. 2016-__ (this "Resolution") are hereby adopted.
- 2. Pursuant to Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the Ordinance, the Council establishes the following recreational marijuana permit and land use review related fees:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional, such invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion will (a) yield to a construction permitting enforcement to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, and (b) not affect the validity, enforceability, and/or constitutionality of the remaining portion of this Resolution.
