#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-12**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LA PINE AUTHORIZING WILDERNESS GARBAGE & RECYCLING SERVICE TO INCREASE ITS SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE RATES.

WHEREAS, La Pine Disposal & Recycling, Inc. ("Franchisee"), an Oregon corporation d/b/a Wilderness Garbage & Recycling Service, provides solid waste management services in City of La Pine ("City") pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2007-3 (the "Franchise Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, City and Franchisee have commenced negotiations concerning a new franchise agreement which will replace and supersede the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, during the negotiations, Franchisee will continue to provide solid waste management services subject to and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 3A of the Franchise Agreement allows City to approve a rate increase if, among other things, a governmental unit raises the cost of providing service; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 25, 2017, a copy of which is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a>, Franchisee has requested that City approve rate increases for solid waste collection services, which increase reflects the pass-through costs of the garbage disposal (tipping) fee increase charged by Deschutes County; and

WHEREAS, City desires to approve Franchisee's requested rate increases in accordance with the Franchise Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by and through the La Pine City Council (the "Council") meeting in regular session, the following:

- 1. <u>Findings</u>. The above-stated findings contained in this Resolution No. 2017-12 (this "Resolution") are hereby adopted.
- 2. <u>Franchisee Obligations</u>. During the franchise agreement negotiation process between City and Franchisee, Franchisee will continue to provide solid waste management services in City's incorporated limits subject to and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement.
- 3. Rate Increase. Pursuant to Section 3A of the Franchise Agreement, commencing on October 1, 2017, rates for the solid waste collection service provided by Franchisee under the Franchise Agreement will be those service rates set forth on the attached Exhibit B. Effective October 1, 2017, the solid waste collection service rates identified on the attached Exhibit B amend, replace, and supersede in all respects those solid waste collection service rates established by Franchisee and approved by the Council on or about January 13, 2010. Any further adjustments to Franchisee's service rates will require Franchisee to first satisfy those conditions provided under the Franchise Agreement, including, without limitation, obtaining

Council's prior approval. Franchisee will provide its customers written notice of the service rates increase no later than September 1, 2017.

4. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional, such invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion will (a) yield to a construction permitting enforcement to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, and (b) not affect the validity, enforceability, and/or constitutionality of the remaining portion of this Resolution.
